

## TI108 - Cleaning and maintaining powder coatings

Practical procedure	Rinse with plenty of water. Cleaning with wetting agent solution and use a sponge or soft cloth as an aid. Rinsing and drying.
Specific procedure according to the type of soiling	Remove greasy coatings with a concentrated wetting agent solution, alcohol or surfactant after a short exposure time.
	Lime stains, mortar residues and cement splashes are removed with 1:1 diluted plaster vinegar (9.6%).
	Treat silicone stains and adhesive residues with silicone remover.
	If necessary, treat undefined stubborn stains with facade cleaner (e.g. Ambruch 1, www.ambruch.de).
Notes	Particular attention should be paid to coatings with metallic, pearl mica and dull matt effects. Accordingly, the measures listed under certain procedures must be checked for impairment of the surface.

Absolutely forbidden	Solvent-based cleaners, thinners, acetone, chlorinated hydrocarbons, etc.
	Acids, alkalis, strongly alkaline cleaners
	Scouring agents or abrasive aids
